The Pride of Rogers High School and the Pride of Rogers Heritage High School will honor one graduating senior from Rogers High School and one graduating senior from Heritage High School annually and will be renewable under conditions listed below.

New Tech High School students may apply and be considered through the high school in their attendance area.

The Buck Foundation is looking for students who are future community leaders and understand that strong communities are based on individuals willing to give of their time and talent. The creative project should reflect what this community has given them and made them who they are as they graduate from high school.

Requirements:

- Recipients must demonstrate outstanding school and community involvement and be deemed future community leaders
- A minimum of two school sponsored Clubs/Organizations active participation per year
- A minimum of 30 hours to date of community volunteerism/participation other than in school or church
- Solid students, **but those whose income level or academic achievement does NOT qualify them for other significant financial assistance**
- An ACT score of **24-30**
- Minimum GPA of **3.5**
- Recipients must attend a 4-year college or university
- **A short, creative submission which expresses the applicant's appreciation of his school and/or community. This may be in any creative form- art, photo montage, scrapbook, essay, etc. A short DVD, CD, or Power Point presentation will also be accepted.**

Applications will be disqualified under the following conditions:

1. A project requires more than 5 minutes for review.
2. A project weighs more than two pounds, and/or is difficult, fragile or bulky to transport or store.
3. The application and/or project contain blatant grammatical or spelling errors.

4. Digital media projects are not user-friendly and are not operable on various types of equipment or media software.
5. An applicant has been disciplined by, expelled or suspended from his school.

IMPORTANT:

Questions regarding Pride applications must be directed to the scholarship coordinator at the applicant's school. To avoid any undue favoritism or the perception of such, applicants or the parents of applicants should not directly contact Buck Foundation Scholarship Committee members.

Finalists will be required to attend an interview session.

Applicants are encouraged to follow the Buck Foundation on Facebook. A link to the page can be found on the Buck Foundation website www.buckforscholarships.com. Information and updates regarding the Pride scholarships will be posted periodically during the application period.

**AMOUNT- \$8,000 first year
\$32,000 total value per scholarship if renewal conditions are met**

RENEWAL CONDITIONS:

Pride scholarships are renewable for up to 4 years total. Renewal requirements include maintaining a 2.5 grade average and taking a minimum of 12 hours per semester. Those requirements may be waived upon a written appeal. In that event, a probation period will be instituted. Written correspondence from recipients relating their college experiences will be required at the end of each school year.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS:

Buck Foundation scholarship payments are administered by the Rogers Development Foundation. Recipients must abide by their criteria for release of funds.

The foundation reserves the right to omit awards if applications received do not meet standards.

NOTE: If you are submitting a digital media project, it must be downloaded to your Google Drive. You will then "share" the project with the Buck Foundation at:

It is your responsibility to confirm the program you use to create your digital project is compatible with Google. Test it with several remote computers, including a Mac. If it cannot be opened, your project will unfortunately be disqualified.
