It is also used to determine financial need for other scholarships.</p> <p>Federal student aid can be used to cover the costs of tuition and fees, room and board, books/supplies, and transportation. It is made up of three main types of aid:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Grants - funds for college that do not have to be repaid. ■ Work-study - part-time employment where you can earn funds while enrolled. ■ Loans - borrowed funds.
